CHAMPAGNE

Perrier-Jouët Grand Brut, France

Dynamic, fresh and lively, showing white flowers, grapefruit and notes of pineapple and honey.

Perrier-Jouët Rosé, France

Dynamic. This Champagne Rosé combines vinosity and roundness, but as the same time maintains a lively and fresh spirit. It is a large, structured cuvée with 20% reserves wines.

Moët & Chandon Brut Impérial NV

Moët & Chandon is the worlds most loved champagne since 1743. Moët Impérial is the houses icon.

Moët & Chandon Brut Imperial Rosé

Rose Imperial is a spontaneous, radiant, romantic, expression of the Moët & Chandon style, a style distinguished by its bright fruitiness, its seductive palate and its elegant maturity.

Louis Roederer Cristal 2012, France

This world-renowned Champagne was first created for Tsar Alexander II all the way back in 1876, and it has remained a massively well-respected Champagne ever since. Fresh and fruity, with bursts of juicy orange and white peach developing alongside hints of chalky minerals.

Perrier-Jouët Belle Epoque 2012, France

As ever, this is bursting with fresh florals and vibrant fruit, with an underlying complexity stemming from biscuity notes and drying mineral hints. The bottle also remains wonderfully distinctive as previous vintages.

“R” de Ruinart Brut NV, France

From a champagne house with a long and distinguished history dating back to 1729, making it the oldest still producing wine. The palate is rich and creamy with a touch of butterscotch, brioche, white fleshed pear and aromas of white flowers.

Dom Pérignon Brut 2010, France

A fitting tribute to the genius of the monk from Hautvillers who carried out much research to improve the quality of Champagne. Roughly equal proportions of Pinot Noir and Chardonnay are blended and then left to mature for seven years prior to release.

Nyetimber Classic Cuvee, England

Complex tastes of honey, toasted almond and baked apples. A great combination of intensity, delicacy and length.

Nyetimber Rose NV, England

Creamy, round texture with refreshing redcurrant, raspberry and cherry flavours. Suggestions of brioche lead into an elegant, silky finish.

Bottega Gold Prosecco Brut, Italy

Characteristic, fruity with scents of golden apple, Williams pear, acacia flowers and lily of the valley.

20cl Bottle £11.00

Fantinel Prosecco Extra Dry, Italy

Fresh, dry and fruity, a pleasant and extremely elegant bouquet with delightful, floral hints.

Angel & Four, England

Fresh, dry and easy-drinking, with enticing aromas of white peach and apricot, and delicious apple and citrus flavours.

Freixenet Ice Cuvee Cava, Spain

Made from a blend of traditionally used Cava grapes. designed to be served over ice, with enticing hints of wild flowers, peach, ripe pear and a gentle sweet finish.

Da Luca Prosecco, Italy

A classic example of the Giera grape grown in the Prosecco region. Pear and peach fruit on a lively, yet soft and generous palate.

RED WINE

Tekena Merlot, Central Valley, Chile

Copper-tinged, salmon pink with redcurrants on the nose and a mineral character.

The Riddle Shiraz-Cabernet, Australia

Spicy pepper, raspberry and cherry of the Shiraz and the blackcurrant, capsicum and mint of the Cabernet. Lightly oaked, soft and mellow.

Da Luca Nero d’Avola, Terre Siciliane

Bright and lifted fresh cherry and bramble fruit aromas on the nose; the palate is generous, yet not weighty, displaying a fruit salad of red and dark berries and a note of vanilla oak on the finish.

Côtes du Rhône, Les Abeilles Rouge, Jean-Luc Colombo, France

Fresh and silky on the palate, the aromas of small red fruits follow through, prolonged by notes of liquorice and spice.

Solandia, Primitivo di Puglia, Italy

Velvety, ripe Blackberry and Plum fruit with a touch of vanilla spice. Primitivo is a native grape of Southern Italy and well known as a variety that produces generously flavoured wine with a spicy edge to them.

Santa Rita 120, Pinot Noir, Acarangua, Chile

This Pinot Noir has a pale ruby red colour. Lovely aromas of fresh cherries, raspberries and a hint of spice with cinnamon and mocha.

Fruit forward with blackberry and black cherry aromas and spicy notes: the palate is balanced and mouth-filling with a rich texture and long finish.

Errazuriz Late Harvest Sauvignon Blanc, Casablanca Valley, Chile

Honey, raisins, and dried apricots tremendous texture and volume on the luscious and fresh palate.

WHITE WINE

Da Luca Pinot Grigio, Terre Siciliane, Italy

Aromas of white flowers, pink grapefruit and cox's apple the palate displays melon and guava.

A popular blend, combining a soft creamy texture with lime flavours and subtle oak characters that deliver a crisp dry white wine.

Ripe gooseberry and citrus aromas with herbaceous notes, showing some tropical fruit and lime on the palate.

Ripe melon, peach, passion fruit, gooseberry and a hint of cut grass on the nose: the palate shows tropical fruits and refreshing lime.

Sourced from three vineyards in the premium area of Awatere Valley, the low yields result in a wine with intense tropical fruit aromas and flavours, with a delicious just off-dry finish.

Aromas of ripe tangerine, honey and apricot with subtle notes of toast and smoke.

Cortese grapes, showing floral and citrus aromas, with a mineral, dry palate.

Expressive nose of green apples, pear and lemons, with hints of herbs and flower blossom: clean and textured palate with refreshing citrus flavours amplified by mineral accents.

Generous and ample, the wine has a floral bouquet with aromas of fresh fruit, nuanced by a fine minerality.

Belvino Pinot Grigio Rosato delle Veneto, Italy

A delicate pink wine full of fresh, summer-fruit aromas and flavours. Made using pink-skinned Pinot Grigio grapes from the Venetian wine region

Wicked Lady White Zinfandel, California, USA

Medium-sweet, with delicious raspberry and strawberry flavours.
